Re-use and Repair Review

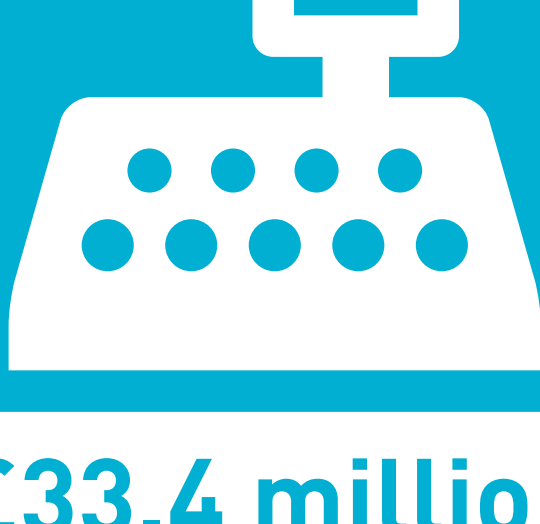
